

#### Introduction

TribeFinder is a web application that helps users locate the nearest tribal offices. Enter a ZIP code to instantly view nearby offices on an interactive map, along with contact details, distance, and links.

#### **Getting Started**

- Open the TribeFinder app in your browser: https://tribefinder.greatlynxdesigns.com/
- 2. On the home screen, type a ZIP code into the field labeled Enter ZIP code.
- 3. Choose whether to view the Nearest 5 or Nearest 10 results
- 4. Click Find a tribe!
- 5. The map updates to show red markers for each nearby tribal office. A list of the same offices appears beside the map, with names and details.



## Viewing Office Results

- Each **red marker** on the map represents a tribal office.
- The **list on the right** shows the offices in order of distance from your ZIP code.
- Each office entry includes:
  - Tribe name and office address
  - Leader name (if available)
  - o Email contact
  - **Distance** (in kilometers and miles)
  - Website link

Clicking a link will open the tribe's website in a new tab.



### **Tips & Troubleshooting**

- **Invalid ZIP code**: If no results appear, double-check your entry. Try a nearby ZIP code if needed.
- Nearest 5 vs. 10: Use the radio buttons to control how many results display.
- Map controls: Use the +/- buttons to zoom in or out, or drag the map to explore.
  Toggle between Map and Satellite views.
- No nearby tribes: Some areas may not return results; expand the search by choosing "Nearest 10."
- Accessibility: Navigate using the **Tab** key, press **Enter** on buttons, and use your browser's zoom/high contrast settings for improved readability.
